UNSW Adjustment Factors

For 2022 entry, students can get up to 12 points across all our schemes for eligible degrees.

<u>Elite Athletes, Performers and Leaders Program</u> recognises achievements in sport, academia, leadership and music at an elite level. Students must submit an application and provide supporting documentation by 30 November to be considered.

<u>HSC+</u> rewards students who perform well in Year 12 subjects that are relevant to their preferred UNSW degree. Students can use our <u>HSC+ calculator</u> to see how many points they can get for their subject performance.

<u>UAC Educational Access Scheme</u> considers factors impacting academic performance including illness, financial hardship, language difficulties or attending a particular school.

University of Newcastle Supports Elite Athletes

Closes by 31 October

You may be considered for an ATAR adjustment up to 4 points should you be recognised as an Elite Athlete as a school leaver or University applicant.

An application for Elite Athlete Status must be submitted no later than 31 October (or for mid-year applicants by 30 June) and should the application be successful, confirmation of status as an Elite Athlete will be provided to the University of Newcastle admissions team.

If athletes do not meet the current criteria or the sport/organisation is not currently recognised by Sport Australia, applicants will be notified. Applicants are welcome to apply for special consideration for admission on the grounds of sporting commitment / achievement and how this may have impacted study. A statement should be provided (to the University of Newcastle Admission team admissions@newcastle.edu.au with the UCAC application number as soon as possible) outlining achievements and how sporting commitments may have impacted study resulting in a lower ATAR or overall grades.
